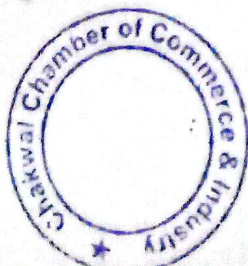


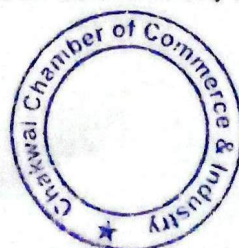

| 1 | The Secretary General shall display election schedule on the notice board of CCCI, website and submit a copy to office of the Regulator of Trade Organizations. | 9 th July 2026

| 2 | The member concerns of the Chamber desiring to change their representative shall intimate changes regarding name of representative to the Secretary General along with necessary proof. | 11 th July
2026
Saturday |
| 3 | The Secretary General shall display the provisional list of all members eligible to vote along with their National Tax Registration Number, Sales Tax Registration if applicable, the name and national identity card number of their representative at Notice Board and website of the Chamber. | 15 th July

| 4 | The members who have any objection to the entries/changes in the list of voters shall send their objections in writing to the Secretary General | 21 th July

| 5 | The Secretary General will intimate action on the objection or changes sent by members. | 25 th July

| 6 | Any member aggrieved by the decision of the Secretary General, taken in the preceding clause, may make a representation to the Election Commission. | 27 th July

| 7 | The Commission will decide the representation. | 29 th July

| 8 | Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Commission or where the Commission fails to decide the representation within the stipulated time mentioned in the preceding clause may appeal to the Director General, and decision of the Director General in this regard shall be final. | 31 st July

| 9 | Director General will decide the appeal. | 10 th Aug

| 10 | The final list of voters shall be displayed at notice board and at website of the Chamber and shall also be submitted to the D.G.T.O. | 12 th Aug

| 11 | Any person who is eligible to contest the Election for the vacant posts of the Member Executive Committee to obtain nomination papers from Secretary General. In the same manner women entrepreneurs desiring to contest the election for the reserved seats in the Executive Committee for women to obtain nomination papers. | 15 th Aug

(Candidate have to pay charges at the time of obtaining nomination paper PKRS.15,000 Non-refundable)



- 12 Submission of nomination papers duly proposed, seconded by a duly registered voter and signed by the candidate, to the Secretary General on the prescribed form in accordance with the Articles of Association or Rules of the Chamber 17th Aug
2026

- a) The secretary General shall provide a copy of final list of voters to each contesting candidate except the candidate of women seats, as their college is the Executive Committee.
- b) Scrutiny of the nomination papers and letter of authority by the commission. This clause ipso Facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.
- c) Circulation by the Secretary General of the list of nominees whose papers have been declared valid and the forms of withdrawal to the said nominees. This clause ipso-facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.
- 13 The objection if any, to the nomination of candidates can be filed to the Election Commission. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats. Provided that the candidate for a particular seat will file objections for the candidate of the same seat and for the same class. 19th Aug

- 14 The Election Commission will decide the objections filed under the preceding clause. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats. 21st Aug
2026
Friday
- 15 Any candidate, aggrieved by the decision of the Election Commission, taken under preceding clause, where the Commission fails to decide within the time stipulated in the preceding clause may file an appeal to the Director General. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats. 22nd Aug
2026
Saturday
- 16 The Director General Trade Organizations shall decide the appeal preferred under the preceding clause. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats. 28th Aug
2026
Friday
- 17 The Secretary General will receive the withdrawal forms from the nominees completed by the nominees who want to withdraw from the Election. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats. (9:00 am to 11:00 am) 29th Aug
2026

- 18 The Commission will issue final list of candidates. (3:00 pm) 31st Aug
2026
Monday
- 19 The polling at the registered office of the Chamber for Corporate as well as Associate Members. Counting of votes shall take place immediately after the polling hours under the supervision of polling officer in the presence of polling agents of the candidates, if any, at the designated site. The Election Commission shall declare provisional results. The Election Commission will conduct election for the seat reserved for Women Entrepreneurs. Provisional results shall be declared by the Election Commission, about the women reserved seats. 5th Sep

- Any person elected as member of Executive Committee to obtain nomination papers from Secretary General for election as an office bearer.
(Candidate have to pay charges at the time of obtaining nomination paper
President: PKRS.40,000, Senior Vice President: PKRS.35,000, Vice President: PKRS.30,000

- 21 Submission of nomination papers to the Election Commission for election as office bearers duly proposed, seconded by an elected Executive Committee Member and signed by the candidate. (9:30 am to 11:30 am)

Tuesday
- 22 Scrutiny of the nomination papers for the election of office bearers by the Commission and display of final list of candidates.
(2:00 pm to 4:00 pm)
- 9th Sep
2026
Wednesday
- 23 Polling for the election of office bearers.
(10:00 am to 12:00 pm)
- 12th Sep
2026
Saturday
- 24 The announcement of election results shall be made in General Meeting of the Chamber called for this purpose.
- 25th Sep

- 1) For the purpose of this schedule "Day" means working hours of the Chamber on that day unless otherwise stated.
- 2) If any day on which an act scheduled to be performed under the election schedule falls on a holiday, such act shall be performed on the day next following the holiday(s)
